Board and Committee Reports

Session

Learned that there will be a commissioning service in August for Helen Richardson prior to her departure to serve as a Young Adult Volunteer for the PC(USA) in Scotland.

Received an updated estimate on funds received (and still forthcoming) from the June yard sale.

Received as information that the Missions Committee raised \$321 from the bake and plant sale which was part of the yard sale.

Received an update regarding the work of the Electronic Sign Committee.

Learned that the Pentecost offering raised \$1,500, \$600 of which went to support the 6:8 Project's Summer Lunch Program.

Learned that the Nominating Committee has begun its work.

Received as information that upcoming NEED dates are 6/29 and 7/30 and that the church is seeking a coordinator to email volunteers.

Learned that the Habitat project finished early and that plans are being made to rehab 80 older homes in the same neighborhood.

Heard a report on the trip to the Tarrant County Black History and Genealogical Society and about future Social Justice projects which may include a letter-writing campaign related to the family separation policy.

Learned that new Communion ware has been received and the Worship Committee is exploring possible ways to enhance worship in the Sanctuary.

Received a report on how well the two presentations by participants in the music and mission camp were received at Parkwood and Legacy.

Learned that the multigenerational Sunday school class has a Skype interview scheduled with a missionary in Bolivia.

Summer Opportunities to Study & Learn at Emmanuel

As Presbyterians, we believe we respond to God's grace and attend to the presence and action of God in our lives through practices of discipleship, including the study of Scripture both individually and with others. Two adult classes continue to meet every Sunday in the summer to study Scripture from 8:45-9:45am and invite your participation:

- Spiritual Journey's class meets in Room 4 and is doing an overview of the Bible using the book *The Complete Guide to the Bible*, by Stephen M. Miller.
- Keys to Scripture class meets in Room 5 and is studying the Epistles.

Additionally, the Intergenerational Class (adults, youth and children) meets twice a month after worship during the summer.

Church School Class Updates

Two adult Church School classes continue to meet at 8:45 AM: Keys to Scripture in Room 5 (study of Epistles) and Spiritual Journeys in Room 4 (overview of the Bible).

A summer Intergenerational Class (adults, youth, and children) meets twice a month after worship at 11:15 AM. The two July sessions are:

July 1st. *A Year in Glasgow: Cragneuk & Belhaven Parish*. Helen Richardson shares about the Young Adult Volunteer (YAV) program of the Presbyterian Church (USA), which she will begin August 20th with a one-year assignment to Scotland.

6:8 Project: Volunteers Needed for Summer Lunch Program June 11—August 17

The 6:8 Project is sponsoring a Summer Lunch Program at the 6:8 House, 1912 Portland in Fort Worth from June 11th—August 17th. This is our fifth year to work with Greenway Place residents on this rewarding project! We provide lunch Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays for children (up to 18 years old) in the Greenway neighborhood. Tarrant Area Food Bank provides cold lunches two days a week and The 6:8 Project provides a hot lunch one day a week, as well as the location and supervision. The lunch program insures that neighborhood children, many of whom receive assistance with lunch during the school year, continue to have healthy meals while school is out. In addition to lunch, we offer enrichment activities for the lunch program attendees to develop and build community and to serve other people in their neighborhood.

We need volunteers to help with the program, which is from 11 am—1:30 pm on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays; there are several ways you can assist :

- Assist onsite with a children's enrichment activity such as reading books aloud, supervising the computer room, making crafts, working on a service project, and playing indoor and outdoor games.
- Prep an enrichment activity, such as a craft, educational activity, or service project. This can be done on your own time, at home.

Mission and Music Camp Recap
