

Board and Committee Reports

Session

- 1. Approved the Mission Committee's request for approval to hold an enchilada fundraiser dinner on Sunday, July 1st, from 5-7 PM, \$10/person minimum, to benefit the Intergenerational Mission Trip.
- 2. Learned that Emmanuel's next days to work at NEED will be Thursday, May 31st, and Friday, June 29th.
- 3. Learned that the last four Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Clean-Up Buckets will be assembled by the Mission Camp in June to be delivered to Arkansas.
- 4. Heard that the Habitat House is ahead of schedule despite rain.
- 5. Voted to take the cost for the Yard Sale storage building out of unrestricted memorial funds, up to \$600.
- 6. Voted to approve and accept the bid from Boenker Insurance for the upcoming year.
- 7. Learned that the theme of the Mission and Music Camp scheduled for June 18th-21st is "God is Calling All of Us, Young and Old".
- 8. Learned that the theme for the Summer Intergenerational Church School class will be "Missionaries Around the World", with Skype interviews to be scheduled with those serving in various mission ministries.
- 9. Learned that the outside door key code will change June 1st and quarterly.
- 10. Heard that the One Great Hour of Sharing offering raised \$2,267 and the Capital Goods offering raised \$1,103.
- 11. Was informed that Shred Day raised \$300 in donations with \$80 raised from the plant sale.
- 12. Received a report on the May 19th Stated Meeting of Grace Presbytery held at First Presbyterian Church, Richardson, which included recognition of Helen Richardson who will serve as a Young Adult Volunteer to Scotland.

6:8 Project: Volunteers Needed for Summer Lunch Program June 11—August 17

The 6:8 Project is sponsoring a Summer Lunch Program at the 6:8 House, 1912 Portland in Fort Worth from June 11th—August 17th. This is our fifth year to work with Greenway Place residents on this rewarding project! We provide lunch Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays for children (up to 18 years old) in the Greenway neighborhood. Tarrant Area Food Bank provides cold lunches two days a week and The 6:8 Project provides a hot lunch one day a week, as well as the location and supervision. The lunch program insures that neighborhood children, many of whom receive assistance with lunch during the school year, continue to have healthy meals while school is out. In addition to lunch, we offer enrichment activities for the lunch program attendees to develop and build community and to serve other people in their neighborhood.

We need volunteers to help with the program, which is from 11 am—1:30 pm on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays; there are several ways you can assist:

- Assist onsite with a children's enrichment activity such as reading books aloud, supervising the computer room, making crafts, working on a service project, and playing indoor and outdoor games.
- Prep an enrichment activity, such as a craft, educational activity, or service project. This can be done on your own time, at home.
