- Elected Linda Villarreal to serve as commissioner to the May 19th meeting of Grace Presbytery at First Presbyterian, Richardson.
- Voted to grant permission for the Mission Committee to host the bake sale at the June 2nd Yard Sale. The proceeds go toward the Intergenerational Mission Trip to Memphis.
- Voted to designate 40% of the Pentecost offering which Emmanuel retains to support the 6:8 Project Summer Lunch Program.
- Learned that the Worship Committee authorized payment of \$200 to the Good Friday liturgical dancer from the Special Worship & Music Fund; \$150 to the Easter trumpet player from the Outside Musician Fund; and payment to the 2 jazz musicians for Pentecost from the Special Worship & Music Fund.
- \$6,000 was collected for Habitat for Humanity and \$2,119 for One Great Hour of Sharing.
- The Finance Committee is investigating changing the internet and phone provider for the Church Office.
- Learned that Personnel will broaden the search for Director of Faith Formation by sharing the position description with seminaries.
- Heard an update on Cub Scout 254's new leadership and they will participate in worship on May 13th (Mother's Day).
