Board and Committee Reports

Session:

- Learned about the projected budget goal for 2019 and plans for information to be shared at the stewardship luncheon on October 14th.
- Was informed that nametags will be made for regular visitors and that a new church directory is in the works.
- Was informed that Personnel Committee will be meeting soon to discuss staffing for the nursery, the Director of Faith Formation position, and staff reviews and that Nancy Cable will serve as Moderator, beginning in January.
- Learned that a tree fell on the 6:8 House and that the roof hole is to be repaired.
- Learned that green tips will be shared on a regular basis in the church newsletter, as well as the Sunday bulletin.
- Was made aware that the Itasca Christmas party is scheduled for December 8th and the 6:8 Christmas party is scheduled for December 15th.
- Learned that an intergenerational Advent workshop will be offered on December 2nd, the first Sunday of Advent, as well as an Advent worship service at 4:00 PM the same day during church school in the sanctuary.
- Heard about projected facility enhancements planned by BCAMP.
- Received a status report on the electronic sign contract, which will be signed very soon.
- Learned that two worship workshops are planned for children and youth, one on Oct. 21st and the second on Nov. 11th.
- Reviewed two statements for the EPC website, "What We Believe" and "New to Emmanuel?", with instructions for session to bring back proposed edits to the October meeting.
- Received dates for new and all-officer training.
- Learned that ordination/installation of officers will take place on January 20th.
- Was informed that a confirmation class may take place in January, with confirmation scheduled for Palm Sunday, April 14th.

Deacons:

- The Deacons will keep a few prepackaged Grace to Go bags in the kitchen cupboard ready to be given out by staff or members.
- Our winter clothes closet will be inventoried and warm clothing will be added to prepare for winter.
