Safety is a BIG priority at EPC!

Did you know that we have a Safety taskforce that has been making progress behind-the-scenes for EPC? Here's the first in a series of articles to keep you in-the-know.

Taskforce members are Jim Mahon, Mary Ann Reed, James

Taylor, Kyle (interim pastor) and Jayne Johnson. Our goal is to provide a safe worship place (for all of us) and a secure working environment for our Pastor and office staff. The plan will consider multiple scenarios for active shooter, fire, and tornado safety ac-

A few highlights:

tions.

- Session, Deacons and office staff attended a 2-hour evening training: Civilian Response to Active Shooter Event (CRASE) training with the Bedford Police Department in the fall.
- Jim, Mary Ann and James also attended a 1-day hands-on intensive safety training program at the Presbyterian Church in Grapevine that was organized by Grace Presbytery. This training included safety tips, actual class situations to respond to as well as group discussions.
- After the CE building renovation was completed, we requested a Safety Assessment from the Bedford PD for all our property and have thoroughly reviewed the findings.
- Several no-cost actions have already been implemented and recommendations for several more actions are under consideration currently. Examples: locked external doors before and during worship services, close monitoring of parking lot and people entering the building, addition of Exit signage for the sanctuary (through the choir door) and notes added to the weekly bulletin.
- We will be presenting the findings and recommendations to Session for approval in the coming weeks. Implementation planning and timing are in progress too.

SESSION COMMITTEE REPORT

Noted reception of letter of transfer for Dina M. Ferreira from St. Philip Presbyterian Church, Hurst

Learned that the Moderator's weekly sabbath occurs on Fridays and Saturdays and that she will attend the National Council of Church's Faith and Order Meeting May 17-20

Received the report from commissioners Jayne Johnson and Katie Phillips of the hybrid Stated Meeting of Grace Presbytery March 4, 2023, at Trinity Presbyterian Church, McKinney

Rejoiced in the successful first Concert on Harwood, held on March 25th, with 60+ individuals in attendance

Noted White Elephant Exchange scheduled for May 21st at 11:15 AM, with hot dogs and chips; Car Show on Saturday, June 17th, 8-10 in the parking lot

Session was encouraged to give YELP reviews to increase EPC's social media presence

Was informed that Local Benevolence Special Offering totaled \$290; Habitat fundraiser was @ \$7,000, and March Concert on Harwood received \$460.

Noted that Childcare Worker Kelly Balthrop had been added to the 1099 payroll

CE building fire inspection was completed and signed off on by Bedford Fire Department

Was informed that alternative software companies are being reviewed to replace Church Windows

Voted (1) to use unused EPC classroom space to organize and store items for the April 29th yard sale and (2) to designate profits from the sale above the \$4,000 budgeted line item to be used toward the purchase of a permanent storage unit, with limited access, for sellable items only

Learned that Facilities Committee approved James & Sheryl Taylor's request to use SoRelle Hall for a reception following worship on Sunday, August 6th to celebrate with Emmanuel their 50th wedding anniversary August 4th

Was informed that the 2012 rental fees need to be readdressed and updated

Was reminded that NEED day for March is March 31st and received an update on college scholarship student Olivon Duron on his studies at Heston College

Over 60 people attended the March 19th Habitat fundraiser, 20 people participated in the Cowtown Cleanup on March 25th, and 3 attended the Grace Presbytery Social Justice Task Force Hidden History bus tour of historic sites in Dallas in connection with Black History Month

Learned that a Techno-Recycling box has been purchased for use at the church and that Shred Day is scheduled for May 20th

Noted that Worship Committee welcomed Brittney Axton as Director of Music, added a Prayer for Illumination by the liturgist just prior to reading and preaching of The Word, and that Communion by intinction will be reinstated in April


