

BOARD AND COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHTS- Session Committee Report

- Learned that Molly Park will email session members when it is time to renew their Praesidium training
- Was informed that the Clerk of Session took the 2023 Minutes for review on March 23rd and that they
 were approved and that a friendly financial review between Treasurers was recommended for church
 es who have not had a financial audit
- Voted to call a congregational meeting for April 7 for the purpose of amending the Pastor's terms of call. This will adjust how much is designated as her housing allowance to reflect a home purchase this year. It will not affect the total compensation.
- Approved the Medical Leave Plan as presented by Personnel for Whitney which places her on Temporary Disability with the Board of Pensions from May 14th to June 11th, which was explained in detail
- · Was informed that Finance approved renewing two CDs which are due in April
- Noted that Whitney's deferred income (SECA) had been corrected for 2023 and 2024 and that money
 owed to her has now been paid
- Was informed that Whitney will take Continuing Education to attend the Fellowship for Protestant Ethics Summer Symposium "Reimagining Vocation in Precarious Times" July 11-14, 2024
- Learned that the Local Benevolence Special Offering raised \$645 and Habitat for Humanity contributions to date totaled \$8,580, with more funds anticipated
- Heard that the Deacons requested to evenly split the balance in Sunday Hospitality Fund to create a new Deacons Memorial Support Fund
- Heard that the next Intergenerational Sunday Session is scheduled for May 19th, focusing on Pentecost
- Learned that VBS is scheduled for July 29th-31st
- Was informed that Becky Baker has a copy of the updated vendor list and that the spring work day on March 16th went well
- Heard that Emmanuel will sponsor one table at the May 1st Presbyterian Children's Home and Services annual luncheon
- Noted the following dates from Outreach and Connection committee:
- Eclipse Day viewing on April 8th at 1:00 pm
- Blessing of the animals on April 20th, 11-noon
- Arbor Days April 27th, from 10-2; (2 crafts provided)
- Concerts on Harwood April 27th at 4:00 PM -- Aaron Walton, organ
- Heard about plans to move organ speakers to enhance quality of sound and what that might entail, a
 joint project of Facilities and Worship Committees
- Learned that pulpit supply is being secured for the Sundays when Whitney is on Medical Leave
