Ordinary Time

We are, without a doubt, in the dog days of summer that are August in Texas. For some, school is kicking off again, and with it, anticipation, perhaps anxiety, and a return to familiar rhythms. For others, these days bring yet more sweltering heat, electric bills that are far too high, and dwelling places that are far too warm. For many of us, August is a sort of pause button to the year - not quite yet at the new beginnings of September when the days (hopefully!) begin to cool around the edges. There is no big holiday, no big change . . . just late summer life. August is the embodiment of what in the church calendar we call Ordinary Time. However it may sound, or feel, Ordinary Time is a gift to us, even in



August. Because we can, in these dog days of summer's end, take a moment to be exactly where we are, as we are. We can, with God's help, take stock of what has come before, and what we hope for in the coming seasons. Board and Committee Reports

SESSION COMMITTEE REPORT

Highlights of June 25, 2023 Session Meeting

- Received an update from Leah Wyckoff on recent activities of the Board of Deacons
- Learned that Nancy Hollingsworth was interested in joining Emmanuel as an active member on July 2nd
- Was informed of plans to record short videos from members on why they choose to be a part of Emmanuel as part of the upcoming stewardship campaign
- Whitney shared information regarding a Grace Presbytery learning event September 11-14 at Camp Gilmont designed to help churches make space for belonging for the LGBTQIA community.
- Learned that the door code would be changed soon and was given the new code
- Received information that the PNC has begun face-to-face interviews with candidates which will continue and that the committee anticipates concluding its work in August and bringing the name of the person they believe God is calling to serve as Pastor to the congregation for vote
- Was informed that 33 users have been invited, 20 have enrolled and 18 individuals have completed the Praesidium Training
- Learned that 27 individuals attended the classic Car show
- Was informed that 2 bids have been received on repair work for the A/C unit and that the supplemental check had been received from the insurance company related to renovation
- Learned that, following research, the church office will continue to use the Church Windows software
- Heard that the Habitat house construction was ahead of schedule and that the Tech Recycling Box is ready
- Was informed that Becky Baker planned to cover the phones from 8-10 am on Tuesdays, in Jessica's absence
- Learned that 77 people attended the second Concert on Harwood and that liturgist training was scheduled for July 16th
