Church School Class updates for December include:

Children and Youth (K-12<sup>th</sup>) Classes. The children and youth are taking a break from their course *Learning to Study the Bible* for an Advent study "Preparing the Way" that explores the themes of love, hope, joy, and peace in the context of Christ's birth.

**Keys to the Bible.** This class continues their in-depth study of 2 Samuel using John Goldingay's book 1 and 2 Samuel for Everyone.
