BOARD AND COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHTS- Session Committee Report

VOTED to dismiss Helen Richardson to Maxwell Street Presbyterian Church, Lexington, KY, which she had joined in August, 2021 and where she is serving on session (never communicated to session), commended her to their care, and removed her from the EPC roll

Noted that confirmation of baptism of Valerie Grossack on August 20th, 2020, by The Rev. Rob Erickson had been researched and shared with her in order for her to become a member of and be married in 2025 in the Catholic Church she attends in the Boston area

Elected Jayne Johnson and John Stocking to serve as commissioners to the Zoom Called Meeting of Grace Presbytery on Thursday, December 7th, at 10:30 AM

Heard about plans for the Longest Night Service scheduled for Thursday, December 21st, at 7:00 PM. Noted that the Christmas Eve Lessons and Carols Service is scheduled for Sunday, December 24th, at 5:00 PM

Learned that Pastor Whitney will be on vacation December 26th - January 3rd, and that The Rev. Dr. Lucia Kremzar will be supply preaching on December 31st

Discussed a way for session to express gratitude and love for Scott Keyes for his service on session

VOTED to approve a 4% across-the-board merit increase for staff and learned that job descriptions have been updated

Noted a request from a member for a worksheet showing each committee's monies as presented on the balance sheet for the December meeting

Was informed that the Clerk of Session had the 2022 Session Minutes reviewed on November 4th at the Presbyterian Mission Center and that they were approved, with exceptions

Learned of the change of plans and that Kroger holiday gift cards will be distributed prior to Thanksgiving and Christmas through NEED

Heard that the Nominating Committee continues to work to fill one slot. Once the slate is complete, an electronic vote of session will be taken to call a Congregational Meeting to elect new elders and deacons

Heard that the Community Issues class on Creation Care and the environment is going well.

Was reminded of the Intergenerational Advent Kickoff on Sunday, December 3rd, following worship.

Was reminded of the Community Christmas Dinner on Sunday, December 17th, from 5-7 PM

VOTED to leave the Happy Hands line item off of the budget for 2024 and to send the \$115.09 remaining in that fund to Hesston College to support Olvin Duron

VOTED to add Camp Gilmont Support to the Mission Budget in the amount of \$600 annually (\$50/month)

VOTED to approve the tentative Concerts on Harwood series for 2024 as presented by Worship Committee:

- June 2024 date and time TBD Chris Heldt trumpet recital
- Sept. 14th at 4:00 PM Mehrdad Gholami flute recital
