At-Home Project: Lunch Bags for Presbyterian Night Shelter

Emmanuel's Mission Committee will collect Lunch Bags curbside in Emmanuel's parking lot on Saturday, February 6th from 10 AM - Noon to deliver to Presbyterian Night Shelter in Fort Worth. Please make the lunch bags at home and bring them to Emmanuel February 6th or arrange with Melissa Durkee for delivery/pickup prior to February 6th.

Presbyterian Night Shelter will distribute these bags to people without permanent housing, many of whom are camping outside. They don't have access to kitchen tools, so canned items need to have pop-tops.

Many thanks for your help and support in caring for our neighbors through this project!

Lunch Bag Instructions:

Please use a 1-gallon resealable plastic freezer bag for the lunch items; the person receiving it can reuse the plastic bag as waterproof storage for their belongings. Include these items in each bag:

- *A water bottle
- *Plastic spoon rolled in a napkin or paper towel
- Plus four or five of the following:
 - *Fresh Fruit (small apple, orange or mandarin) or dried fruit (raisins, apricots, apples)
 - *Pop-top canned fruit
 - *Pudding cup
 - *Foil tuna pack or tuna & cracker kit
 - *Energy bars or protein bars
 - *Peanut butter crackers or cheese crackers
 - *Pop-top canned meat
- Optional items:
 - *A note of encouragement
 - *Travel/trial size hygiene items (soap, wipes, hand sanitizer)

COVID Vaccine Registration Underway



Tarrant County Public Health is currently providing initial vaccinations to those at most risk of exposure to COVID-19. Phase 1A and 1B groups include healthcare workers, first responders, as well as individuals 65 and older, and 18 and older with an underlying medical condition. Tarrant County is distributing the Moderna vaccine at this time, which is only available to individuals 18 and older. Please pre-register for an appointment at www.tarrantcounty.com/covidshot.

Once you register, you will receive confirmation via phone call, text, and/or email. Please note that registering only places you in the queue. The timeframe to receive the vaccine is dependent upon individual factors such as age, occupation, and underlying health conditions. You will receive a specific appointment time from Tarrant County when it is your time to receive the vaccine. The City will provide updated information on vaccine distribution as soon as it becomes available.



A Lenten Journey : Prayer Practices and Prayer Groups for Lent

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 17th. Emmanuel’s Christian Education Committee is providing *A Lenten Journey* resource for our community to use during Lent. This is a resource for people of all ages and stages to use at home during Lent. *A Lenten Journey* takes us through Lent with focus on a different prayer practice each week. Each prayer practice comes with suggestions for modifying/adapting the prayer practice for children, youth and adults.

We are also forming weekly prayer groups for Lent. Small groups of 3-5 people will meet online weekly prayer gathering during Lent using *A Lenten Journey*, we are forming prayer groups of 3-5 people. Group Gatherings Schedule for February

All Emmanuel’s weekly group gatherings remain online while Tarrant County COVID risk levels remain in the red level. You are welcome and encouraged to participate as you are able!

Online meeting links and phone numbers are included each week in the Emmanuel Weekly Update email and are also available by contacting the church office (office@emmanuelpc.org). The current weekly schedule for online gatherings is:

Sunday’s

- 9 AM: Keys to the Bible class** meets for Bible study. The class is starting a study of Old Testament prophets.
- 11 AM: Fellowship Hour.** This time for checking in and sharing prayer concerns is open to everyone. Prayer concerns from this gathering are shared by email to congregants during the week.
- 4 PM: Children and Youth Check-in and Devotional.** Children and youth meet with two adults from the Christian Education committee for about 45 minutes to share how they are doing, read and reflect on scripture, and pray together.

Tuesday’s

- 7 PM: Weekday Evening Bible Study** meets and explores one of the Scripture passages from the previous Sunday’s worship.

Thursday’s

- 7 PM: *Race in America*,** a 5-part online series sponsored by Grace Presbytery to study systemic racism and the Black experience with the goal of cultivating anti-racists. Led by Rev. Dr. Michael Waters, the series meets each Thursday in February.

Saturday’s

- 11 AM: Children and Youth Book Club** meets to read and discuss books. The books are appropriate for ages 10+, and the group includes interested adults. The **book for February is *Swing it, Sunny***, by Jennifer and Matthew Holm. Contact Leah Wyckoff (klh@sbcglobal.net) to be included.

The Mission Committee received approval from Session to create a Pandemic Fund for distributing money to members and family who need it during this quarantine. We are able to supplement payments of rent, utilities, insurance, car payments and repairs, medicine, and food. (Cable bills are excluded.)
