
#### Saturday's

# **Board and Committee Reports**

#### SESSION:

Learned of committee assignments of elders-elect as follows:

Molly Park - Christian Education

John Stocking - Evangelism

James Taylor - Finance and Stewardship

Pat Wiegand - Mission and Social Justice

Was informed of new COM contact, The Reverend Jake Clawson (Trinity Presbyterian, Flower Mound)

Discussed being proactive after the Congregation Beth Israel hostage situations and received links to resources for congregations seeking knowledge and preparation for violent events

Set a proposed date to reschedule the second meeting of session with staff from Project Regeneration

Voted to postpone February Communion until the first Sunday when the congregation has returned to the Sanctuary and it is safe to unmask.

Rescheduled Ordination/Installation of Officers until the first Sunday when the congregation has returned to the Sanctuary

Approved moving \$1,000 from the Pandemic Fund to the Vaccine Clinic Fund, noting that the next two clinics are scheduled for January 29th and February 19th

Voted to accept changes to the 2022 budget resulting from updating the A/C Maintenance account from \$1,300 to \$1,600 to cover inspection of all CE and main building units

Was reminded that Local Benevolence Special Offering will be collected on February 20th

Voted to take \$500/month from the Local Benevolence Fund over the next four months to donate to NEED to replenish perishable food as well as personal care items

Voted to move \$7,000 from Unrestricted Memorials to the PNC fund

Elected Kristin Hartwell and Laura Mahon as commissioners to the February 12th Stated Meeting of Grace Presbytery

Elected Pat Wiegand to serve as second elder to the 2022 Nominating Committee, to be moderated by Scott Keyes

Was informed that expenses for 2021 exceeded income by \$4,341.97, rather than by the \$10,232 amount projected
