They were called *ammās*, the Greek word for mothers. These were the women of the 4<sup>th</sup> century of Christianity, after Christianity had become a state religion. These women took to the wild to discover many things: freedom, autonomy, devotion, solitude, humility, and community. But their main desire in the wilderness was God. There they encountered a God who forged relationship not in easy, comfortable surroundings, but in the wild: in sand-scrubbed terrains, in every precious drop of water, in haunting quietness, in the dark night and sunrise of the soul.

In our time of instant gratification, of the constant pressure to perform our faith in just the right way for others, of increased isolation and fear and dread, we need the wisdom of these women. We need the *ammās* to show us the way back – an ancient way of following Jesus into the wilds where we can remember our own agency, our worth, and our purpose. We need the *ammās* to show us the way forward – to discover a modern ascetism that honors the body woven through with spirit, and a peace within ourselves that comes from God to us as pure gift.

This Lent, these *ammās* beckon us to leave our comfortable distractions and disjointed over-functioning and journey with them into the wild with Jesus. There, we will meet our true faces. We will be exactly where we are, unafraid of truth. We will practice the slow way of listening for the Spirit to speak. We will find companions for the journey. We will rediscover our purpose together. We will walk with humility, and we will rediscover our wild, free, full humanity.

Sometimes, the only way forward is back. Let's follow the wisdom of these desert mothers, the *ammās*, into the very heart of God found in the wild and untamed places. There, we will see ourselves, as we truly are. We will see this world as it truly is. There, we will see God.

## BOARD AND COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHTS

### Session Committee Report

- Session elected Ken Richardson as Chair of the congregational Nominating Committee.
- Learned that Personnel and Finance Committees have approved the proposed Terms of Call for Whitney for 2026 to be voted by the congregation at the Annual Meeting
- Was informed of the following Intergenerational Workshop Dates:

March 8th	middle of Lent
May 24th	Pentecost
Aug. 9th	Blessing of the Backpacks
Nov. 29th	1st Sunday of Advent (tentative)
- Heard that Frank LeCocq will serve as Chair of Christian Education
- Learned that Codi Gragg, childcare worker, has completed Praesidium training and plans to reorganize the nursery
- Heard that worship committee has 3 new members and thanked Melissa Durkee for agreeing to oversee the ushers
- Was informed that the goal is to have at least one member of the Safety Task Force present for special events (concerts, etc.)
- Session voted to approve changes to the 2026 Budget as shown in V1.4
- Session voted to grant permission for Nancy Cable and Tonia Thompson to list the art pieces from Wanda Asire's estate and to report revenue to session which will be deposited in unrestricted memorial funds
- Elected Jude Langsdorf to serve as commissioner to Special Meeting of Grace Presbytery on January 24th (subsequently, postponed, due to the weather)
- Elected Melissa Durkee and Tonia Thompson as commissioners to the Stated Meeting of Grace Presbytery on February 26th at Trinity Presbyterian Church, Flower Mound
- Learned that Emmanuel ended calendar year 2025 with a surplus of \$36,940.01 versus a predicted deficit of \$22,264
- Was informed that Finance moved \$3,000 from General Fund balance to increase the Capital Goods Escrow to \$18,000
- Session voted to move \$150.41 from the Vaccine Clinic Fund and to write a check to the Angel Fund to benefit Meadow Creek Elementary kids
- Session noted that Presbyterian Night Shelter bags will be assembled on March 15th
- Session voted to approve the fundraiser for Habitat for Humanity on Palm Sunday, March 29th, with a potluck lunch
