To address the growing need of food insecurity among college students, the TCC food pantry began in 2016 serving 110 students and grew in 2017-2018 to serving over 1,800 students. This academic year, in 2018-2019, the food pantry served over 2,500 students and began offering fresh food free of charge about once a month. These numbers are only for the Northeast campus down the road in Hurst.

In August, we will begin trying to support their efforts by trying to focus on specific items they need. One thing they need are microwavable meals so students can eat while they are there - something like microwavable mac and cheese, etc. The 3rd weekend in August (19th) will be the TCC food pantry day and we will focus on one item per month.

On Sunday, June 9, 2019 the Pentecost Pot Luck Luncheon was held in Sorelle Hall after Worship.

Many thanks to Mary Ann Reed who coordinated the food and decorated the hall with red, yellow, and orange balloons, flowers and matching tablecloths, napkins, cups and plates.

A wide variety of meat dishes, sides, salads and desserts were enjoyed by many. A big Thank You goes out to everyone who helped with set-up, clean-up and those who cooked and brought such delicious food to share with everyone!

3. Approved a full-time contract for The Reverend Chuck Schneider as Temporary Pastor, effective June 23 - December 31, 2019, to be renewed if appropriate, with notice of termination by either party with 30 days notice.

4. Made an adjustment to the membership roll.

5. Welcomed Financial Administrator Christine Shah and granted privilege of the floor.

6. Saw a mock-up of proposed stewardship pledge card which will be produced in-house.

7. Heard details of the Mission Trip scheduled for July 22nd - 26th.

8. Received a report from the 2018 Nominating Committee and approved a Congregational Meeting to be held on Sunday, July 14th, at 9:45 a.m. to receive the committee's report and to fill the vacancy in the Session Class of 2020.

9. Learned that Mission Committee is scheduling a monthly Community Dinner on the last Sunday of August, September, October, and November as a pilot project.

- 1:14 PM. Board DART train to DFW Airport
- 1:31 PM. Arrive DFW Airport Terminal A and walk 0.25 miles to Terminal B TEXRail station.
- 1:55 PM. TEXRail train departs DFW Airport.
- 2:03 PM. Arrive Grapevine Main Street station.
- 2:05 PM. Carpool back to Emmanuel
