

SESSION:

Voted to move \$3,000 from the Local Benevolence Fund to the Pandemic Fund

Received a report from Commissioner Kristin Hartwell on the May 14th hybrid Stated Meeting of Grace Presbytery at Canyon Creek Presbyterian Church, Richardson

Noted receipt of a letter of transfer of membership for new (returning) member Molly Bolles from First United Methodist Church, Hurst

Was informed that the Mission Study task force will be ready to present their work to session soon

Discussed structuring a committee night and the need for each committee, as well as session, to determine method of meeting (in-person via Zoom), date and time -- to be sent to Kyle and Jessica

Learned that a congregational walk-through of the restored and renovated Christian Education committee will be scheduled, once complete, including a dedication/blessing, upon recommendation of the Facilities

Was informed that Facilities Committee will be meeting with The Clubhouse for Special Needs to update the contract prior to their move into the CE building, hopefully, by July Committee

Rejoiced in hiring of Mackenzie Pappas as part-time childcare worker

Learned that ceilings have been installed and that floors and plumbing are next to be installed in the CE building

Was informed that Remi Halo filters have been installed in the Sanctuary, offices, and one in SoRelle Hall and a new capacitor for office A/C

VBS will be scheduled for either July 19-21 or July 26-28, depending on response, with 9 am-noon and 5:30-8:30 format, using the curriculum <u>Making Connections with People, Nature and Creation</u>

Intergenerational Sunday school classes will take place following worship on June 12th and July 10th, using the VBS themes and activities

Learned that the church website will be undergoing a total revamping

Learned that John Field and Melissa Durkee will attend the Habitat Heroes Awards Dinner on June 2nd to receive an award being presented to Emmanuel

Voted to approve in concept Tak Yan Yeung's concert series to begin in 2023 and to establish a fund to accept freewill offerings to support the series

Was informed that Peace and Global Witness Special Offering will be collected on June 26th, that One Great Hour of Sharing Special Offering totaled \$1,110, Habitat for Humanity Special Offering raised over \$7,900, and NEED Cars for Coffee collected \$220.
