As college students finish up exams and transition to the summer, we've been reminded several times lately about the growing need of food insecurity among college students. By some estimates, as many as half of all college students may not have enough money for food. About 45% of students said they have limited or uncertain access to food according to a recent survey.

To address this growing problem, Tarrant County College has started and recently expanded its food pantry for students. Many people in this congregation either work at TCC, have been students there or are connected to the college in some way. The Social Justice Committee would like to begin supporting their work by offering once a month collections targeting specific items they need for their food pantry.

Watch for regular notices starting in August about what items the food pantry needs.

## **Board and Committee Reports**

## Session:

- Was reminded that Shred Day is scheduled for Saturday, June 22nd.
- Learned that the Nominating Committee meets May 30th to begin work to fill the elder vacancy in the class of 2020.
- Heard about work in progress to address the water leak in Room 108 and drainage issues in the courtyard and by the CE building.
- Was informed that the 6:8 Project summer lunch program begins June 10th and that a summer intern will be hired.
- Heard from Pastor Chuck about his primary objectives as he serves Emmanuel during this time in the life of the church.
- Was reminded that the Pentecost Offering will be collected June 9th and voted to allocate the local 40% to the 6:8 summer lunch program.
- Learned of work done recently both inside and outside the facility, including removing of a rock retainer wall and a small tree, a wasp nest, and replacement of a light fixture for the courtyard.
- Was reminded of intergenerational earth cares Sunday school classes on the first Sunday of June, July, and August.
- Heard from Finance/Stewardship regarding payment of the fire alarm premium, as well as the building insurance renewal and plans to seek a competitive building insurance bid for 2020.

## **Deacons:**

- Meals: The only meals that are currently needed are for Keith Royal. Two meals a week are sufficient. People can also give gift cards instead of providing meals, and some have already been given (Jason's, Uber Eats) which were greatly appreciated.
- Fellowship: Pentecost Sunday is on June 9, 2019. Deacons can help Mary Ann Reed with set-up (probably that Saturday) or clean-up afterwards.
