

Church School Class Updates

Studies underway continue in most classes, and a new Lenten study begins in the Thoughtful Christian class.


Children and Youth (K-12th) Classes. The children and youth did a close study of our Brief Statement of Faith and the verbs it uses to describe Jesus. In the weeks leading up to Easter, they are exploring Jesus' ministry using the Bible stories that describe what Jesus says and does. Note: There will be no Church School class for Children and Youth on March 29th, as they are attending presbytery-sponsored camps for children and youth that weekend.

Keys to the Bible is starting a study of 1 Peter using N.T. Wright's *The Early Christian Letters* as a resource.

Spiritual Journeys. The Spiritual Journey class reads and discusses the lectionary scripture passages used in Sunday morning's worship. The schedule of lectionary passages can be found on the Spiritual Journeys class webpage at:

The Thoughtful Christian class begins a Lenten study of the devotional book For the Beauty of the Earth, by Leah Schade, as the basis for daily prayer and Sunday class discussion. The 40-day Lenten devotional focuses on the splendor of nature, how God nurtures our spirit through creation, and how we can protect our precious home. The class invites you to read the book and pray with them during Lent, even if you aren't able to participate in class discussions. 
Earth Day at The Dapper
