LOCAL BENEVOLENCE

RULES OF THUMB:

We seek to be generous church but we also need to be mindful of our limitations and security issues of our staff, Clubhouse staff and Clubhouse community members. We are not equipped to be a full social service agency. As such, we should stay focused on what we are able to do.

These "rules of thumb" are recommended for all members and all staff including the staff:

1. Please do not give cash to those in need to those in need on the church campus. This invites problem with escalating inquiries of those looking for quick cash. Through word of mouth, our church ends up with negative influences onto our campus if we give out cash. This further comprises staff and Clubhouse safe-ty.


2. Absolutely **do not let anyone in the doors of the church unless you know them** or it is arranged ahead of time. If alone in the church, do not answer the door under any circumstances for someone you don't know.

3. <u>People receive assistance ideally by contacting Becky via church office phone</u>. She invites them to pick up this assistance on Wednesday mornings. Sundays and days other than Wednesdays we unfortunately cannot assist anyone beyond a gift card and grace-to-go. You can refer to NEED or other agencies (Becky has a list). <u>Again, do not give cash</u>.

4. <u>Exceptions for grocery cards</u> are made to the above for Emmanuel members and regular participants. <u>The pastor needs to clear these exceptions</u> in direct conversations with those requiring the extra assistance.

5. **Exceptions are not made regarding financial assistance.** We follow the benevolence policy recently approved by session for members and non-members alike. Only session (not the pastor) can approve assistance beyond the policy's scope. Only the session can approve additions to any ongoing Family Assistance previously approved.

Thank you for helping us keep a system within our capabilities to help those in need. Thank you for understanding our limitations and reflecting both what we can and cannot offer out into the community.






FLOWER CALENDAR OPENINGS
