November Service Project: Hygiene Kits provide comfort and help prevent disease for people around the world. Presbyterian Disaster Assistance distributes kits with the items below. Each kit is approximately \$15 and donations of all amounts – money and items – are greatly appreciated!

- 1 hand towel (approximately 16" x 28", no fingertip or bath towels)
- 1—washcloth
- 1 wide-tooth comb (remove from package)
- 1 nail clipper (with or without metal files or emery boards)
- 1 bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- 10 Band-Aids® or other adhesive bandage strips

(Toothbrush and toothpaste are not needed; they will be added later!)

Church School Class updates for November include:

Children and Youth (K-12th) Classes. The children and youth continue their course *Learning to Study the Bible*. They learned about the link between gratitude and worship in their second Fall Worship Workshop on October 20th; many thanks to Rev. Chuck Schneider for leading it!

Keys to the Bible. This class continues their in-depth study of 2 Samuel using John Goldingay's book 1 Samuel and 2 Samuel for Everyone.

Spiritual Journeys. The Spiritual Journey class reads and discusses the scripture passages from the lectionary used that morning in worship. It's an opportunity to prepare hearts and minds for the morning worship service, and each week's discussion is stand-alone so it's easy to visit or participate as you are able.
