<u>Sunday's</u>



Would you like to continue the conversation on race in a group from EPC? Many of you joined in with presbytery and synod conversations but we have the opportunity now to have this conversation with each other and to beta test a brand new course being put together by former PCUSA moderator Rick Ufford-Chase in concert with Johnson C. Smith Theological Seminary. Johnson C. Smith is our ONLY historically black seminary in the PCUSA located in Atlanta, Georgia. From the course: "If you are looking for a primer to help you sort out the theological questions around systems of White supremacy or to prepare you to be a more effective ally in dismantling structural racism, The "Awakening to Structural Racism" Block of five "Foundations" is for you." This course will be moderated/taught by Kyle Walker and resourced by Rick Ufford-Chase. In order to have Rick's participation, we will offer this course over Zoom. Please look at your Sunday afternoon/evening calendar and get back with Kyle so he can make sure we have the interest necessary to have a good conversation group. The courses will begin on Sundays in late October and wrap up by Thanksgiving. A specific timeframe will be set after we hear from the group who is interested.

PNS LUNCH BAG ASSEMBLY


