Letter to the EPC Congregation:

Dear Friends and Members,

The COVID Task Force Committee has been meeting regularly to determine when we can reopen the church building for worship and activities. We are sure that many of you have been following the COVID – 19 developments across Texas and particularly in the DFW area. This is an unprecedented health situation that unfortunately is not subsiding very fast or at all. This is why it is essential that members and friends of Emmanuel continue to take precautions necessary to reduce your potential exposure to COVID – 19 and curb the spread of the virus. We will face this challenge together as a congregation. At this time, we have determined the following:

We have been closely monitoring the severity of the spread of the Coronavirus and have begun to make plans on what to do.

- We will not be re-opening the church building until the virus has declined *significantly*. We are looking at County Health Dept. reports as well as looking at CDC recommendations.
- We are working on a Phasing-in Plan and criteria for reopening that we will present at a later date. We are looking at other churches in the DFW area to see what plans they are presenting to their congregations.
- We are discussing group activities both inside and out to determine the safest means to meet. There will be a follow-up letter with specific details.

We recommend that we continue online worship, fellowship, and meetings at this time. Please continue to practice mask wearing, social distancing, and hand sanitizing.

We will continue to monitor the situation and keep you informed. If you have any questions, feel free to contact one of us.



Board and Committee Reports

SESSION:

Learned about plans for the 2021 Stewardship Campaign "Online Together to Give", that the Stewardship luncheon of pre-packaged boxed lunches would take place on October 11th with Dedication Sunday scheduled for November 15th.

Heard that the Building Fund special offering total was currently \$955, that the church has purchased a ZOOM account, and that Robin's office is getting a new computer.

It was reported that the Worship Committee is discussing a possible outdoor service and other ways to provide Robin with a "live audience".

Learned that the eprayer distribution list is in the process of being rerouted to the Deacons.

Heard that Robin's transition calendar has been updated by the team from Personnel.

It was reported that 35 responses have been received to the Christian Education survey and that back-to-school bags were assembled and delivered to six students.

Approved in concept the creation of a study hall for students, with adult supervision present in the building, once the Covid task group and Christian Education are in agreement on guidelines and protocol.

Learned that parking lot bingo is being planned for September 26th, following Covid protocol, and that Courtyard Cafe' is tentatively scheduled for the afternoon of October 25th.

Heard that the upstairs air conditioner has been replaced by the Facility Committee and that Social Justice is considering a possible book study or email discussion on race relations for the fall.

Received information that Habitat for Humanity is preparing for some volunteer days in the fall and that the Summer Lunch Program averaged 25-30 kids each day.

Voted to amend the Pandemic Fund guidelines to disburse up to 50% of past and future amounts given to Emmanuel staff, members and friends to a local organization that assists the community at large.

Was made aware that the Nominating Committee is forming and is almost complete.

Heard that the Covid-19 Reopening Task Force is sending a letter to the congregation, creating phases for re-entry based on statistical data, and creating guidelines for small groups for inside and outside gatherings, along with a questionnaire for participants.
