**Shred Day:** Saturday, March 21 from 10am-12pm.

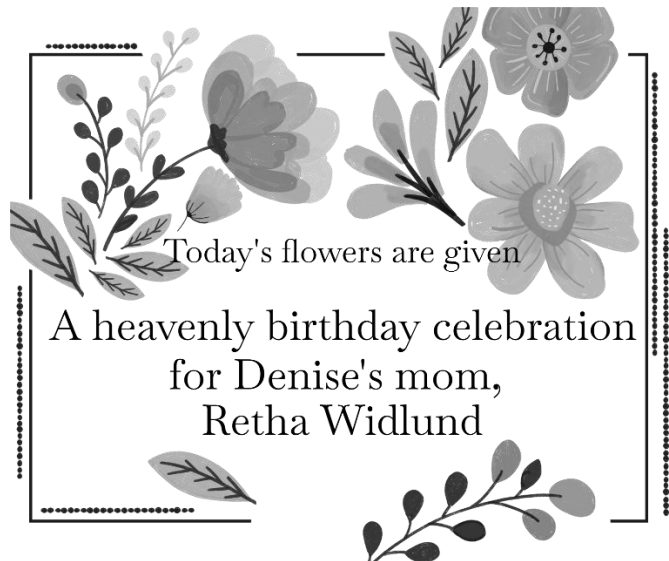
