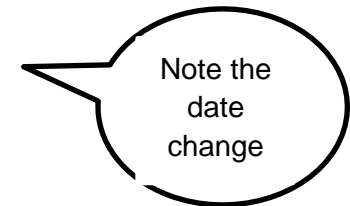
NEWS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS
