Invitation to Confession

We take a moment each Sunday in worship to confess our sin. This is not a time to dwell on our guilt, or feel we are worth very little. This is a time where our honesty is met with God's abundant grace, as we seek healthier paths for ourselves, and the world.

## Prayer of Confession
